Dear Active and Retired Members:

As we approach the end of the Chrysler Twinsburg Stamping Plant, I wanted to remind our members that, regardless of the plant closing and Chrysler's bankruptcy, you are still entitled to workers' compensation benefits for any work-related injuries that you have sustained in the past or in the future.

As you may be aware, for more than 20 years, the Law Firm of Bevan & Associates has represented many of our members on workers' compensation claims, asbestos claims, and personal injury claims as these are matters that are not handled by the UAW Legal Service Plan. In the past, attorneys from the Bevan Firm have come to our Union Hall on Thursday afternoons to meet with any of our members that need their services. Since we have sold the Hall, the Bevan attorneys are available to meet with our members in their offices in Boston Heights at the intersection of Route 8 and the Ohio Turnpike. They can be reached at 330-650-0088.

Furthermore, it is important for you to report any work-related injuries to plant medical immediately. You are entitled to workers' compensation benefits even if you are laid off. Failure to report your claim, however, may jeopardize your rights.
